Booth Sharing: All sharing artists must apply individually and be accepted into the Festival. It is your responsibility to identify and confirm a sharing artist. See the fees for sharing above.  NOTE: Youth artists, age 17 and younger, may sell and share a booth with a Juried Booth mentor. Youth
